



2008 Teal Sound Brass Audition Material

1. Have a prepared piece from your state's solo and ensemble competition that shows lyrical and technical style. You may have 2 pieces that show each skill or 1 that shows both. This piece should be no longer than 1:30.
2. For those aspiring to play a lead part within the Teal Sound Brass please have an additional piece of music that shows your ability to perform in the upper register.
3. Have your major scales learned and be prepared to play them if asked.
4. Be prepared to sight-read a given selection by the caption head.
5. Above all do not be afraid and scared that you will not make the section you are auditioning for. Being a member of the Teal Sound is about making a commitment to perform at your best and have a positive attitude.
